Artificial Intelligence

What It Is

What It Isn't

AI doesn't organize or standardize operations on its own. It relies on centralization, structured processes and human oversight.

What It Does

Turns data into probability-based insights to support operations and enhance resident experiences while maximizing operational impact.

Automation

What It Is

Executes processes consistently and efficiently based on predefined rules within a centralized framework.

Centralization

What It Is
